

Statement of Stacey Bosshardt
Candidate for Steering Committee

I am running to serve on the Administrative Law Community Steering Committee because of my intense interest in discussing administrative law issues with other practitioners. At DOJ, where I spent much of my career, I litigated APA cases. They remain a significant part of my docket at Perkins Coie, where I represent clients in cases involving challenged government action or inaction.
